INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF HEALTH AND WELFARE

IUHW was founded in 1995 as the first comprehensive university of health and welfare in Japan. In the academic year 2019, approximately 9,000 students are enrolled in the 10 schools and 24 departments on 6 campuses located in Otawara City(Tochigi Prefecture), Narita City (Chiba Prefecture), Minato City (Tokyo Metropolitan) ,Odawara City (Kanagawa Prefecture), Fukuoka City and Okawa City(Fukuoka Prefecture).

University Hospitals and Affiliated Facilities

IUHW group has many medical and welfare facilities including five university hospitals and Sanno Hospital, which provide various opportunities for clinical training for students to develop their expertise. Student are also able to experience "Team Care Medicine" in clinical practice and study advanced skills with state-of-the-art medical devices.

IUHW university hospital will be established near Narita Int'l Airport in the spring of 2020

The new university hospital with international features will be established with 642 beds on 91,000m² architectural area. At the hospital, we plan to assign physicians and medical staff with a good command of foreign languages. This will be an international hospital which provides various meals including religious meals and cutting-edge medical services, and has excellent facilities and equipment.
